Melissa grew up in International Falls with close ties to her Ojibwe (Anishanaabe) culture from her mother – with less understanding of her father's Swedish-American roots. At the suggestion of her Swedish aunt, she applied – and was selected - to participate in the Swedish TV show *Allt för Sverige*. On the program, Melissa learned of her Swedish ancestors' difficult decision to emigrate after two years of famine led to the loss of their youngest daughter. *Presentation sponsored by Scandia Heritage Alliance. – Immigrant House Grove*
